**Summary:** Saw 2000 people marching towards Manchester on the morning of August 16<sup>th</sup> 1819.

**Done by:** RH

*Jeremiah Fielding*, examined by *Mr. Littledale*. Was a merchant of Manchester. He was between Manchester and Cheetham Hill, on the road to Bury, on the morning of the 16th; saw about 2000 persons marching in regular order four or five abreast; with music and flags, towards Manchester.

Cross-examined by *Mr. Hunt*—Witness did not see them insult or use any one ill; no women and children were with them when he saw them.
