## CHRONOLOGICAL ACTIVITY ANSWER SHEET

- 1. Protestors assemble in surrounding towns around Manchester.
- 2. First protestors start to arrive on St Peter's Field.
- **3.** 200-300 special constables arrive and form a double line between hustings and magistrates' house.
- **4.** Magistrates issue warrant for the arrest of Hunt and other speakers.
- **5.** Hunt begins speech. The magistrates claim the Riot Act is read, but no independent witness saw or heard it.
- **6.** Manchester and Salford Yeomanry arrive on field, knocking down and killing William Fildes (age 2) on the way.
- **7.** Manchester and Salford Yeomanry advance on hustings. Deputy Constable Nadin & other officers follow and arrest Hunt.
- **8.** Manchester and Salford Yeomanry attack hustings and surrounding crowd. Crowd panics and begins to flee.
- **9.** 15th Hussars arrive, followed by Cheshire Yeomanry. On request from Hulton, Hussars charge to disperse the crowd.
- **10.** Hunt and other arrested reformers taken to New Bailey courthouse to be charged.
- **11.** Captured flag displayed in window of Tate's grocer's shop, New Cross, provoking a riot that continues into the night.
